Margaret Lydia Forrester Lawson, 80, of 2526 North Main Street, died Sunday, October 4, 2009, at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in her health for four years. She had been a resident of Roman Eagle Memorial Home for the past seven months. Mrs. Lawson was born in the Schoolfield community of Danville, VA on March 4, 1930, a daughter of the late C.J.
