

Margaret Brumfield Robertson

May 22, 1936 - September 7, 2021

Margaret Brumfield Robertson, 85, of 679 Hanover Pl, Ridgeway, VA, died on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at her residence after being in declining health for the past seven years.

Mrs. Robertson was born on May 22, 1936 in Pittsylvania County, VA, a daughter of the late Ernest D. Brumfield and Alice Ruth Yeatts Brumfield. She lived most of her life in the Danville area where she was a homemaker. She was a member of Brush Arbor Baptist Church where she had served as past treasurer for eighteen years. 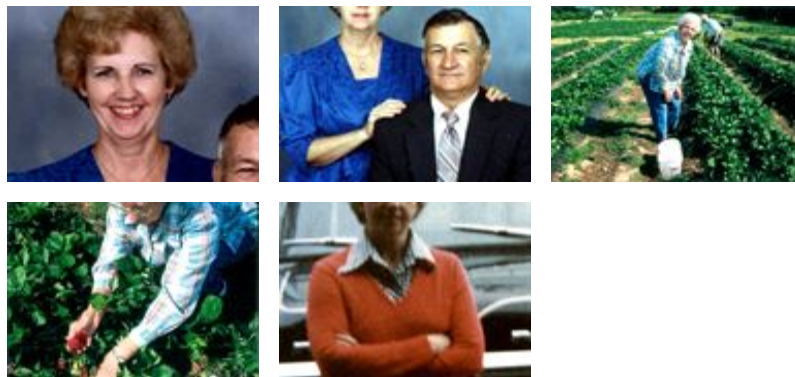
