Margaret Hannah Barker Walters, 91, of the Mountain Hill Community in Ringgold, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, after being in declining health for the past several years.

Margaret was born in Caswell County, NC, on January 1, 1929, a daughter to the late Walter R. Barker and Rosa Bray Barker. She had lived all of her life in the Mountain Hill Community of Pittsylvania, VA, where she was a homemaker. She always enjoyed helping and doing for others. Margaret was a very faithful and active member of Glen Hill Baptist Church as long as her health permitted her to attend. She served as a choir member and she was very much a pillar of the church in her quiet and thoughtful ways. Margaret loved the Lord, her family and her friends.
