Marguerite Richie Caruso, died Monday, November 24, 2014 at The Fountains at the Albemarle, Tarboro, North Carolina after a decline in health.

Mrs. Caruso was born on July 15, 1923 in Pittsylvania County, Va., a daughter of the late Wallace Bane and the late Elsie Compton Bane. She had spent her earlier life in Danville, Virginia where she was employed by Belk-Leggett Department Store and Sears. She moved to Ayden, North Carolina in 1966 where she made her home until 2011. In recent years, Marguerite was a resident of The Fountains at the Albermarle in Tarboro, North Carolina. She retired from Sears after thirty years of service working in both Kinston and Greenville stores. She was a devoted member of St. Peters Catholic Church, Greenville, North Carolina.
