



Marie Bledsoe Gibson

February 10, 1940 - April 10, 2013

Marie Bledsoe Gibson, 73, of 138 Mountain Hill Road Danville died Wednesday, April 10, 2013 at the Blue Ridge Rehabilitation Center where she had been a resident since July. She had been in declining health for the past five years.

Mrs. Gibson was born February 10, 1940 in Danville the daughter of Thomas S. Bledsoe and Ruby Moss Bledsoe Powers. She had lived her entire life in the Mountain Hill Community and prior to her retirement worked in the Standards Department at the Schoolfield Division of Dan River Mills.

Mrs. Gibson was a member of the Lakewood Evangelical Methodist Church where she was a member of the choir and was a Sunday school teacher for the Willing Workers Class. She was also a member of the Mountain Hill Ladies Club.

On July 13, 1957 she was married to Randolph Anderson Gibson, who survives.

In addition to her husband, of the residence, she is survived by a daughter, Sandra Gibson Goodwin and husband, Robert; a granddaughter, Jessica D. Goodwin; a sister-in-law, Shirley P. Bledsoe all of Ringgold and five nieces.

She was the last survivor of her generation and was preceded in death by three brothers, John Winfred Bledsoe, Tommie William Bledsoe and Harvey Neal Bledsoe.

Funeral services will be conducted on Friday, April 12, 2013 at 7:30 P.M. from the Lakewood Evangelical Methodist Church by the Reverend Larry Piatt. The family will receive friends from 6:30 – 7:30 at the church and other times at the residence. A graveside service will be held on Saturday at 11:00 A.M. at Highland Burial Park.
