Marilyn Hebert Hammack, 83, of Keeling, VA, died Tuesday, December 3, 2024 at SOVAH Health of Danville after a decline in her health for the past five years.

Marilyn was born in Kalispell, MT on March 19, 1941, a daughter of the late Dage Herbert and Lillian Winegarden Hebert. She lived in several areas around the United States as a military wife and had been a resident of the Danville area since 1982 following her husband's retirement.
