February 11, 1934 - August 16, 2023

Marion Louise Desormeaux, 89, of 10308 Hwy 86 N, Providence, NC went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, August 16, 2023 at her residence after several years of declining health.

Marion was born in Caswell County, NC on February 11, 1934, a daughter of the late William Hazel Gunn and Lottie Washington Marshall. She lived most of her life in Caswell County. Marion was a graduate of Bartlett Yancey High School. She retired after 25 years from the Virginia Department of Health as an Outreach Coordinator. Marion served on the Board of Big Brothers Big Sisters Organization in Danville, VA. She served as President of the Junior Bowling League and coached for 20 years. She also served on the Board of the Women's Bowling Association. Marion was the first woman inducted in the Hall of Fame of the Danville Bowling Association. She's well known for catering through Giles Flowerland. She was an avid follower of the Atlanta Braves and Jockey Kent Desormeaux, her great nephew.

On February 9, 1953, Marion married Mabry Joseph Desormeaux, who died June, 22, 1980.

Marion is survived by one son, Mabry Joseph Desormeaux, Jr. of Raleigh, NC, one daughter Sherri Lynn Desormeaux and fiance Lee Shelton of Providence, NC, one granddaughter, Olivia Desormeaux and one sister Hazel

Delores Stump of Yanceyville, NC.

She was predeceased by her daughter-in-law Amy Desormeaux, of Raleigh, NC.

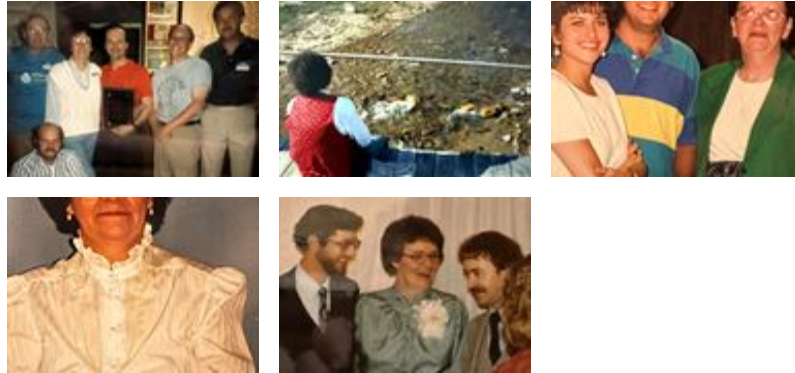
