Mrs. Marjorie Bradshaw Fowlkes, age 93, formerly of 251 Rocklawn Avenue, died Thursday evening, December 30, 2010 at Roman Eagle Memorial Home after a decline in health for the past three years. Mrs. Fowlkes was born on May 20, 1917 in the Turbeville community of Halifax County a daughter of the late Graham Bradshaw and the late Berta Loftis Bradshaw. She had lived most of her life in Danville where she was employed as a bookkeeper for the former Lowenstein's Jewelry Store and later for Haines Jewelry Store. She was one of the first School Crossing Guards hired by the City of Danville. She was a member of Third Avenue Congregational Christian Church.
