August 22, 1957 - October 15, 2023

Marsha Kay Flora Weaver, 66, of Danville VA, went home to heaven on October 15, 2023. She was born in Louisville KY, the brown-eyed dark-haired daughter of a seminary student, Andrew Kyle Flora, and the late Frances Elizabeth Obenshain Flora.

A graduate of Averett College (BA, English) and UNC-Chapel Hill (Master of Library Science), she worked as a children's librarian in Greenville SC, Richmond VA, and Pensacola FL.

Marsha was a unique person of many talents and interests. She was a nature-lover, photographer, folk artist, linguist, musician, writer, seamstress, traveler of Europe, and a connoisseur of hot teas and dark chocolate. She loved folk dancing, and was a member of several folk dance groups, particularly Israeli and international dancing.

Marsha was passionate about the Bible, and carefully studied it in the original languages of Hebrew and Greek. She and her husband also led Bible Study groups. She attended Christ Episcopal Church in Danville.

Marsha is survived by her father, Andrew Kyle Flora of Danville VA; sister, Angela Flora Hall (Richard) of Columbus NC; husband, Allan Cook Weaver of Mickleton NJ; nieces and nephews: Rachel Hall of Columbus NC; Benjamin

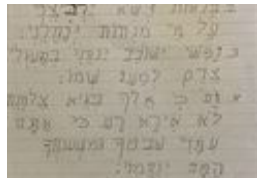
