Marshall Johnson Marshall P. Johnson, 93, of 100 Windsor Trail, Danville, died Friday, December 30, 2011 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past six months. Born on June 16, 1918, in Sandy Level, VA, he was the son of the late Robert P. Johnson and Amy Leftwich Johnson. He worked as a loom fixer for Dan River Mills, and was of the Baptist faith. He was a member of the DAV's Archer T. Gammon Chapter # 19. On July 18, 1942, he married Dorothy Perkins Johnson, who survives. In addition to his wife of the residence he is survived by a daughter, Judy J. Sizemore; a granddaughter, Shanon Wilson, and husband, Tommy; two great-grandchildren, Savannah and Spencer Wilson, all of Burlington, NC.
