Marvin Erie Collie, 94, of 332 Marvin Collie Drive, Ringgold, VA, died Sunday, March 12, 2017 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in his health for the past two months.

Mr. Collie was born in Ringgold, VA on February 7, 1923, a son of the late James Thomas Collie and Sarah Elizabeth Slayton Collie. He lived his life in Ringgold, VA, and was retired as a farmer. He was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church. He was a freemason, a member of Kent Masonic Lodge #305 AF & AM for over fifty years. He was a member of the Pittsylvania County Soil Conservation for over 40 years.

He was a veteran, serving in the U.S. Army in WWII.

On December 13, 1942 he married Carroll Adams Collie, who died on February 16, 2011.

Survivors include two sons, Marvin T. "Tommy" Collie, and his wife Joyce, of Ringgold, VA, and James C. "Jimmy" Collie, and his wife Vicky, of Ringgold, VA; a sister, Carolyn Baumgrandner; four grandchildren, Chip Collie (Charlotte), Wendy Wilson (Brian), Jacquelyn Fackler (Brandon), and Jessica Thompson (Mike); and seven great grandchildren, Eric Thomas Collie, Victoria Collie, Caleb Koger, Joshua Koger, Jaycie Fackler, Lane Fackler and James

Thompson.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by eight brothers and one sister.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 2:00 PM at Kentuck Baptist Church with the Reverend Allen Mahan officiating. Interment will follow in Floral Hills Memory Gardens with Military Honors conducted by the U.S. Army Honor Guard.

The family will receive friends on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at Kentuck Baptist Church from 12:30 until 2:00 PM. At other times they will be at the residence.

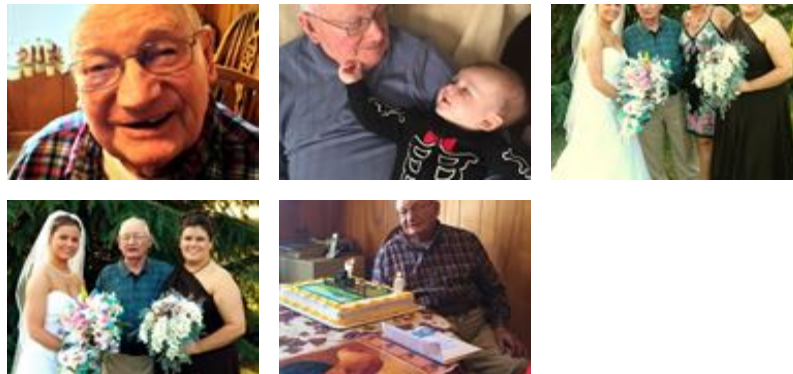
