



Marvin Lynwood Taylor

April 15, 1944 - October 13, 2022

Marvin Lynwood Taylor, 78, of 167 Winstead Drive, Danville, VA, passed away on Thursday, October 13, 2022 at Duke University Hospital after being in declining health since October of 2020.

Lynwood was born in Gretna, VA on April 15, 1944, a son of the late Charles Franklin Taylor and Virgie May Bowen Taylor. He spent his life in the Gretna and Danville areas where he worked for Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company until his retirement after thirty years of service. He was of the Christian faith. Lynwood loved to work on the farm, go hunting, and his favorite thing to do was spend time with his grandchildren.

On June 3, 1967 he married Brenda Fay Daniel Taylor, who died on May 25, 2009.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was predeceased by his siblings, Garnell Taylor and Judy Simpson.

Lynwood is survived by his son, Robert "Bobby" Taylor (Andrea) of Danville, VA; his daughter, Donna T. Eanes (Brad) of Danville, VA; his grandchildren, Andrew, Joseph, Amanda, Evan, Madison and Mackenzie; and his siblings, Bonnie McDaniel and Ricky Taylor (Kathy).
