April 8, 1920 - January 28, 2012

Marvin Jimmy Turner, Sr., 91, of 1572 Fulton Heights Danville, VA died Saturday, January 28, 2012 at the Kindred Hospital in Greensboro, NC where he had been a patient since Tuesday. He had been in declining health for several years.

Mr. Turner was born April 8, 1920 in Greenville County, South Carolina the son of George W. Turner and Eula Thompson Turner. He had lived most of his life in the Danville area and before his retirement had owned and operated Turner's Garage. Mr. Turner was a disabled veteran who served in the U.S. Army during World War II.

He was a member of the Tabernacle and at the former Baptist Tabernacle he served as a Sunday school teacher, a member of the choir and sang with several men's quartets.

On April 8, 1939 he was married to the former Edna Jereline Saunders, who survives.

Survivors in addition to his wife of the residence, include a son, Marvin Jimmy Turner, Jr. and wife, Elizabeth; two daughters, Carolyn T. Campbell and husband, Tommy and Edna Ann Barbour and husband, Thomas; a brother, the Rev. Charles E. Turner all of Danville and a brother, John T. Turner of

Pelzer, SC; eight grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by one sister and nine brothers.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at 2:00 P.M. from the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel by the Reverend R.J. Barber, Jr., the Reverend Joey Bray and Dr. Jimmy Turner III. Interment will follow in Highland Burial Park with military honors by the U.S. Army.

The family will receive friends Monday night from 7:00-8:00 p.m. at the funeral home and other times at the residence.
