



## Mary Jane Hudgins Lovell

June 21, 1934 - January 11, 2020

Mary Jane “Butta” Hudgins Lovell, 85, of Danville, departed this life on Saturday, January 11, 2020 at Sovah Health Danville after a brief illness. She had been a resident at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation & Health Care Center since August.

Mary Jane was born in Danville, VA on June 21, 1934 a daughter George Dave Hudgins and Daisy Gertrude Wall Hudgins.

Mary Jane worked as a Clerk for C&P Telephone Company, which later became Verizon. She was a member of Rivermont Baptist Church. On December 16, 1953 she married, George Ernest Lovell, who died on December 16, 2017.

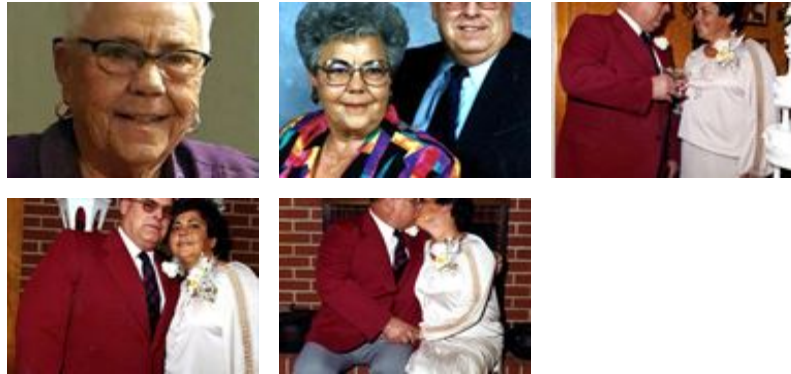
