Mary Jane Stoots Parker, 74, of 1373 Vandola Church Road went home to be with her Lord on Thursday, February 6, 2014 at her residence after being in declining health for several months.

Mrs. Parker was born on January 12, 1940 in Martinsville, VA a daughter of the late William Edgar Stoots and Bessie Haitt Stoots Hockett. She spent most of her life in the Danville area where she was a homemaker. She was a member of Brush Arbor Baptist Church where she was a member of the choir.

On July 20, 1963 she married Bobby Lee Parker who survives of the residence.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Parker is survived by one son, Robert Wade Parker of Eden, NC; one brother, Willard Harrison Stoots and wife Ruby of Dry Fork, VA; two grandchildren, Brittani Ann Parker and Brandi Danielle Parker; and several nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by a sister Callie Ruth Stoots Stacey.
