



Mary Lue Gill Keatts

February 8, 1932 - May 1, 2017

Mary Lue Gill Keatts, 85, of 188 F. E. Keatts Lane, Axton, VA, died on Monday, May 1, 2017 at her residence after being in declining health for the past several months.

Mrs. Keatts was born in Washington County, VA on February 8, 1932, a daughter of the late Aulton Edward Gill and the late Kathleen Eula Wilson Gill. She had lived all of her life in the Axton area where she was an active member of The Church at Sugartree, Primitive Baptist Church for over fifty years. In her spare time she loved spending time with her grandchildren and great grandchildren.

On March 17, 1951, she married Fred Keatts, Sr., who survives of the residence.

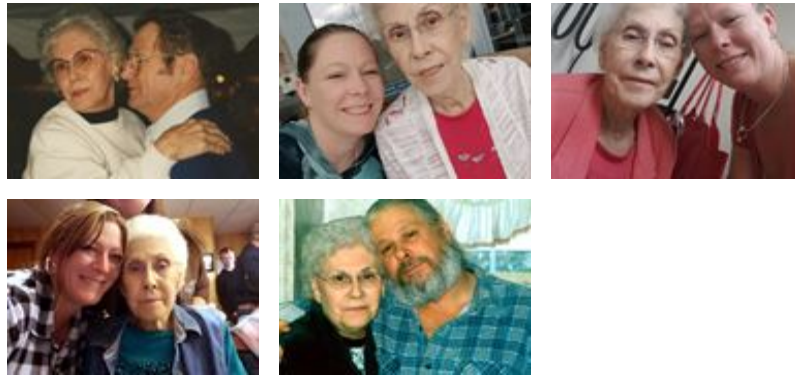
