January 3, 1928 - December 30, 2016

Mary Elizabeth Elliott Robertson, 88, of 3470 Mosco Rd., Axton, VA, went to be with her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Friday, December 30, 2016 at Woltz Hospice Home in Dobson, NC, after being in declining health for the past year.

Mrs. Robertson was born in Axton, VA, on January 3, 1928, a daughter to the late Milton Lee Elliott and Annie Dale Doss Elliott. She spent all of her life in Axton where she was a homemaker and farmers wife. She was a graduate of Axton High School, Class of 1945. She was class Chaplin and graduated as Salutatorian of her class. She was a charter member of the Central Baptist Church, in Axton, where she taught Sunday school and loved taking care of her babies in the nursery.

She was married to Abraham Lincoln "Jiggs" Robertson, who died on December 10, 1987.

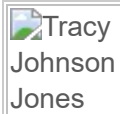

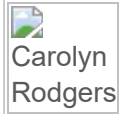
