January 25, 1944 - March 22, 2014

Melvin M. Scott, 70 of Danville, died peacefully on Saturday, March 22, 2014 at Piney Forest Health Care Center after a decline in health for the past three months.

Born in Patrick County, VA on January 25, 1944, son of the late Jona A. Scott and Ada Hill Scott.

Mr. Scott worked for 34 years with the Virginia State Police retiring at the rank of First Sergeant. He served in the U.S. Army in Vietnam and had 24 years with the Army Reserves. Melvin had been employed with Wrenn-Yeatts Funeral Homes since 1994.

Melvin was a member of College Park Baptist Church, American Legion Dan River Post # 1097, VFW Post 647, and the Improved Order of Redmen Poquoson Tribe # 124.

On April 4, 1970, he married the former Joyce A. Mills, who survives.

In addition to his wife he is survived by a son, Brian Scott, and wife, Marti, of Midlothian, VA; a daughter, Beth S. Wyatt, and husband, Jason, of Chatham, VA; four sisters, Shirley Cassell, Ferrum, VA; Hazel Massey, of Stuart, VA; Jane McKaughn, of Martinsville, VA; Elizabeth Stilwell, of Bassett, VA; and a brother, William Scott, of Stuart, VA; a mother-in-law, Hazel Mills, of Danville, VA; four grandchildren that were the love of his life, Benjamin Scott, Jackson Scott, Isabel Wyatt, and Evan Wyatt.

A celebration of life will be held on Friday, March 28, 2014 at 2:00 PM from Faith Memorial Baptist Church conducted by the Rev. Dr. CAM McIntire.

The family will receive friends following the service at the church.
