Mildred Louise Stowe Walton, 78, of 1412 F.C. Beverly Rd, Dry Fork, VA departed this life on Thursday, March 28, 2019 at UNC Health Care Chapel Hill after a decline in health for the past year and a half.

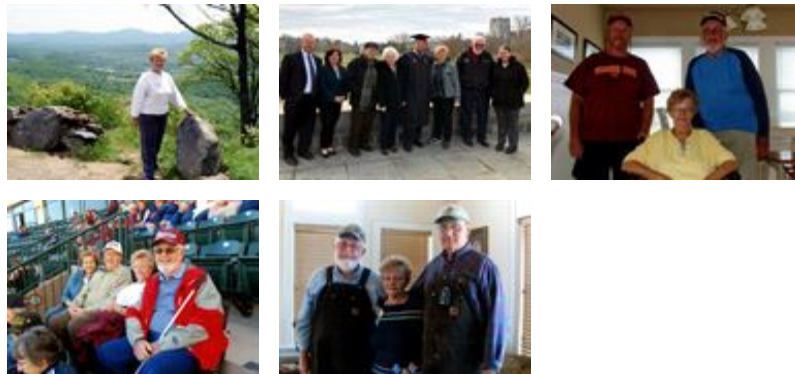
