Moffett Hughes Elliott, Jr., 71, of 203 Belaire Drive, Danville, VA, died Friday, December 6, 2013 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in his health for the past year.

Mr. Elliott was born in Danville, VA on January 23, 1942, a son of the late Moffett Hughes Elliott, Sr. and Euna Bivens Elliott.

He owned and operated Riverside Texaco for fifteen years and later Elliott's Texaco and Towing from 1981 until 1997 and Elliott's Towing from 1997 until his retirement in 2005. He was a member of Moffett Memorial Baptist Church.

On September 3, 1965 he married Joyce Samuels Elliott, who survives.

In addition to his wife, of the residence, he is survived by his son, M.H. Elliott III, and wife Amy, of Danville; his daughter, Kristie E. Trent, and husband Steve, of Danville; a brother, Buddy W. Elliott, Sr., of Danville; his three grandchildren, who were the love of his life and was known by them as Papa, Allison Elliott, Emily and Elliott Trent, of Danville; a nephew, Wayne Elliott and a niece, Nikki Chattin.
