



Molly Lora Freeman Benson

August 16, 1937 - February 19, 2015

Molly Lora Freeman Benson, 77 of 432 Chestnut Ridge Ln, Keeling, VA passed away at Virginia Beach General Hospital on Thursday, February 19, 2015 after a decline in health for the past several years.

Mrs. Benson was born in Hendersonville, NC on August 16, 1937 a daughter of the late Jerry Vestal Freeman and Katherine Lorie Glover Freeman. She lived most of her life in Virginia Beach and was a resident of Keeling since 1997.

Mrs. Benson had retired from her position as a receptionist at a real estate business. She was a member of the Mount Tabor Baptist Church where she taught adult Sunday School and sang in the choir.

On December 14, 1956 she married Ralph Royce Benson who died on August 18, 2004.

Mrs. Benson is survived by four daughters Kathy Frances Campo (John) of Virginia Beach, Toni Lynn Buergey (Steve) of Keeling, Constance Marie Russett (William) of Zephyrhills, FL, and Chauntel Renee Bercaw (Dale) of Keeling; sister Peggy I. Johnson of Hendersonville; brother Jerry Ralph Freeman of Huntsville, AL; eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

In addition to her parents and husband she was predeceased by three brothers Frank Claiyborne Freeman, Jack Vestal Freeman, and Tony Harry Freeman.

A funeral service will be held Sunday, February 22, 2015 at 3 p.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend Carl Burger officiating. A private interment will take place at a later date.

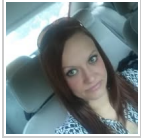
