Molly W. Grant, 94, of Blanch, NC, affectionately known as Miss Molly went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, April 3, 2025.

Molly was born to the late Earl and Lula Belle Williams on July 23, 1930, in Reidsville, NC. She was the first baby girl born at Annie Penn Hospital. She grew up in Caswell County and spent most of her life living in the Blanch, NC community.

She was introduced to Charlie W. Grant and they soon began dating and were married on December 24, 1946.

Molly was first a mother and homemaker. In 1975 she began her career working with the Caswell County Food Service for the public school. During her career she served as the Cafeteria Manager for several Elementary Schools. She served on the NC State Board for school foodservice representing Caswell County. She was instrumental in the startup of the Meals on Wheels Program for Caswell County. Throughout her career she was dedicated to providing nutritional meals to the children in the school system.

She enjoyed her family and spending time with her grandchildren. She was always out on the farm and in her garden. She attended New Hope United Methodist Church and was always involved in the Women's Circle and church activities.
