Mona Patricia Hensley Brotherton, 82, of Danville, VA, died Thursday, November 24, 2022 at Brookdale Senior Living in Danville.

Mona was born in Unicoi County, TN, on September 23, 1940, a daughter of the late Bud Hensley and Mamie Banner Hensley. She lived most of her life in Danville, VA and retired from the Danville Credit Union where she worked as a teller.
