Morris Leslie Giles, 86, of Danville, VA died on Thursday, February 3, 2011 at Danville Regional Medical Center after being in declining health for a year.

Mr. Giles was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on April 8, 1924 a son of the late W. Lester Giles and the late Annie Motley Giles. He spent all of his life in the Pittsylvania County and Danville areas where he worked at Durham Hosiery Mills as a receiving clerk for forty-five years until his retirement. After his retirement he worked part time for Danville Community College until he was eighty three years old. He served his country in the United States Army during World War II. He was a member of the American Legion Post 325 and a life member of Disabled American Veteran's Chapter 55. He was of the Presbyterian faith.

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Mary Irby Giles.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Giles is survived by two daughters, Peggy W. East, of Danville, VA, and Vickie Dale Moore and her husband Timothy, of Danville, VA; one son, Michael O. Owen, and his wife Margaret, of Prospect, VA; nine grandchildren, ten great grandchildren; two nieces, Jane Ragsdale and Belva Flanigan, both of Danville, VA; one nephew, J.B. Newby, of Chatham, VA; and a special cousin, Richard G. Motley, of Chatham, VA.

He was predeceased by one brother, John Winston Giles; and two sisters, Lena Lynch and Bessie Newby.

Funeral services will be conducted on Sunday, February 6, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend Harold Kissler and the Reverend Jerry Flanigan officiating. Interment will follow the service in Highland Burial Park with military honors conducted by the US Army.
