October 7, 1930 - August 28, 2025

Mozelle White Moorefield, 94, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, August 28, 2025, surrounded by her loving family, Keith, Janet, Lindsay and Landon, at the home of her son in Danville, VA. She had been in declining health for about one month.

Mozelle was born on October 7, 1930 in Person County, NC, a daughter of the late William Bradsher White and the late Lucille Howard White. Mozelle was married to her beloved husband, Frank James Moorefield, Sr., for sixty-nine years prior to his passing in 2016.
