Muriel Adkins Boaz Huff, 75, of 130 Ingram Road, died Thursday, June 3, 2010 in Danville Regional Medical Center. She had been in the hospital for the past two days. Mrs. Huff was born on February 13, 1935 in the Sandy Springs community of Pittsylvania County, a daughter of the late Henry George Adkins and the late Fannie Alma Doss Adkins.
