



## Nadie Spain Snead

June 14, 1922 - November 18, 2015

Nadie Spain Snead, 93, of Danville, Virginia, passed away on November 18, 2015. She was surrounded by her loving family.

The funeral service will be held Monday, November 23 at Wrenn Yeatts on 703 North Main Street, Danville, VA.
