



Nancy Poteat Compton

July 18, 1934 - September 14, 2023

Nancy Poteat Compton, 89, of Danville, passed away on Thursday, September 14, 2023 surrounded by her family.

Born in Caswell County, NC on July 18, 1934, she was a daughter of the late Fred Loftin and Nannie Louise Wood Poteat.

On June 26, 1954, she married the love of her life, Leon Desmond Compton. They first met on Craghead Street while she was an intern at a tobacco company. Nancy and Leon were married for over 67 years, until his death on October 16, 2021.

Nancy spent most of her life in the Kentuck Community and was a member of Kentuck Baptist Church. She was a Sunday School Teacher and also sang in the choir. Nancy graduated from Bartlett Yancey High School and attended the University of North Carolina Greensboro. She was a member of the Danville Wednesday Club, the Danville Art League and the Danville Museum of Fine Arts. She was also a Past President of the Kinston Art League (NC).

Nancy worked as a secretary at Chatham Hall, Woodlawn Academy and Hylton Hall before becoming a homemaker, which was the toughest of all. She was a gifted artist and some of her works will be on display at the service.

She is survived by her two sons, Jeffrey Desmond "J.D." Compton, Sr. and Richard Leon Compton (Amy); seven grandchildren, Cameron Compton (Sierra), Stephanie Butler, Ashley Butler, Zachary Alexander Compton (Olivia Adkins), Elizabeth Marie Compton, Alexandria Desmond Compton and Jeffrey Desmond Compton, Jr.; two great-grandchildren, Cole Thomas Compton and Luke Richard Compton and numerous nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents and husband, Nancy was preceded in death by two sisters, Marie P. Oakley and Geneva P. Roberts and a brother, Earl L. Poteat.

A celebration of her life will be held on Sunday, September 17, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. at Kentuck Baptist Church. A reception will follow the service. A private burial will be held at a later date.

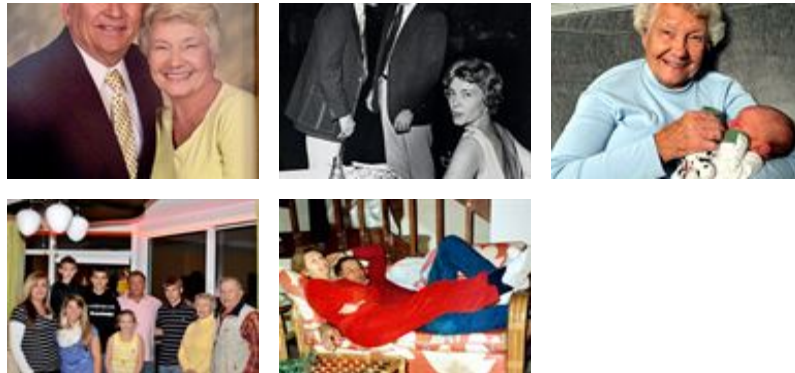
