Nancy Jean Ingram, 73, of 789 Oak Grove Road, Keeling, VA, two-stepped through the pearly gates of heaven on Thursday, September 3, 2015 at her residence after being in declining health for the past five years.

Mrs. Ingram was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on September 7, 1941, daughter of the late Lloyd T. Simmons and the late Addie Mae Davis Simmons. She spent all of her life in the Keeling community where she worked for Dan River Inc. for forty years. When she retired she was working in the Accessory Plant.
