Nancy Marie High Slate, 93, of 1417 Ringgold Road, Ringgold, VA went home to be with her Lord on Wednesday, July 24, 2024 at her residence after being in declining health for the last eight years.

Nancy was born in Crystal Hill, VA on September 28, 1930, a daughter of the late Frank L. High and Lorane Loftis High.
