



Nancy Barbour Smith

July 21, 1946 - April 13, 2023

Nancy Barbour Smith, 76, of 1156 Sugar Barbour Road, Axton, VA, died Thursday, April 13, 2023 at her residence after a decline in her health for the past two months.

Nancy was born in Axton, VA on August 8, 1946, a daughter of the late Edwin Rochester “Sugar” Barbour and Doris Magdalene Reynolds Barbour. She lived most of her life in Axton, VA and retired in 2006 from Charlie’s Frames where she was co-owner and operator with her husband, Charles “C.T.” Smith.

Nancy was a member of Anderson Chapel UMC. She attended the yearly Methodist Conference for the church. She was a founding member of the Sandy River Community Park and she served on the Sandy River Medical Center Board of Directors.

On July 1, 1966 she was married to Charles Thomas “C.T.” Smith, who died on July 19, 2020.

In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by a sister, Diane Kester, and a brother, Ben Barbour.

Nancy is survived by three daughters, Carol Smith Boothe (Christopher) of

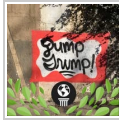

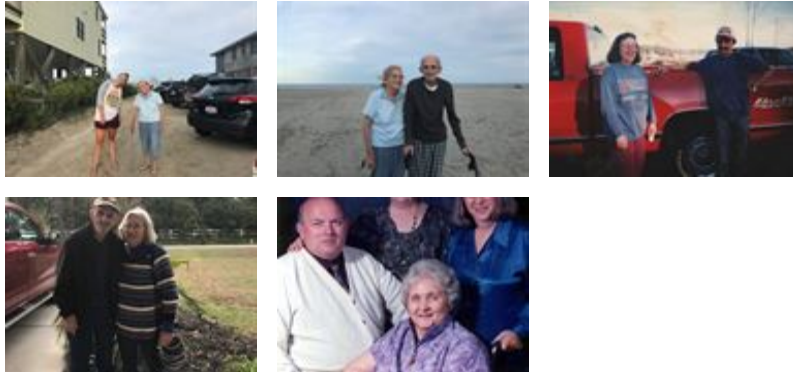
