Nancy Hall Williams Wright of Danville died on July 29, 2009, after battling cancer for a year. Nancy was born in Danville, VA, June 30, 1947 to John Bruce and Betty Varner Hall. She graduated from George Washington High School in 1965 and from Averett College in 1972. She taught 6th grade from 1972 to 1981 for the Danville Public Schools. From 1981 to 1995 she lived in Nokesville, VA, where her husband was the minister of Oak Dale Baptist Church. From 1982 to 1995 she taught English as a Second Language and Adult Education, for Prince William County School. She pursued a Masters degree at George Mason University and received a State Certification in Adult Education. She owned and operated a floral design business. In 1995 she returned to Danville. She served as minister of Youth and Education at Kentuck Baptist Church and then directed a pilot English As A Second Language program at Averett College. In 1998 she began teaching for Danville Public Schools again, most years at the Adult Education Center. She invested her life showing people they can learn, grow, and reach their full potential. She retired in 2008. She was a published writer. She is survived by her husband The Reverend Jeffrey Wright and her sons Michael Williams (Rachael) of Nokesville, VA and Jonathan Wright (Olivia) of Culpepper, VA.
