Nicholas Ted Sapounakes, 64, of Danville, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, September 3, 2021 after a brief illness.

Nick was born in Danville, VA on August 26, 1957 a son of the late Ted Nicholas Sapounakes and Marie Kirios Sapounakes.

Nick was the owner operator of Nick's Towing and Recovery Inc., where he used his catchphrases CNN "call Nick now" or "stuck in the creek call the Greek". At the time of his death he was employed by Atkinson Truck Sales. Nick grew up in the Greek Orthodox Church and was a member of River Oak Church of God, Mount Herman Fire & Rescue., and a life member of the Danville Life Saving Crew.

On June 10, 1989 he married Penny Josey Sapounakes his "strawberry" and her "cool whip".

Survivors also include his son Nick Sapounakes, Jr., his mother-in-law, Bettie Josey, aunts, Mary Kirios, Margaret Kirios, Mary Paraskevas, Ageliki Efstathiou, good friend who was like a brother, Larry Warren, and his beloved dog, Kya. He is also survived by a number of cousins.

He was predeceased by his grandparents, Harry & Kalomira Kirios, Nicholas
