Norman Linwood Hardy, 92, of 2909 Golf Club Road, Danville, VA went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, September 21, 2016 at his residence.

Mr. Hardy was born on August 21, 1924 in Pittsylvania County, VA son of the late Oscar Robert Hardy, Sr. and the late Mary Jane Ricketts Hardy. He spent all of his life in the Pittsylvania County area where he was a farmer until his retirement. He was a member of Mt. Hermon Baptist Church where he served as a deacon, Sunday school teacher and worked with the youth. He was also a member of the Farm Bureau. Mr. Hardy was an avid hunter and fisherman. He proudly served his country in the United States Army.

Mr. Hardy was first married to Estelle Davis Hardy who died on May 19, 1970. He then married Dorothy Hutchins Hardy who died on September 3, 2002.
