



## Norman Eddie Poteat Sr.

January 28, 1919 - August 3, 2019

Norman Eddie Poteat, Sr., 100, formerly of 1181 Parks Springs Rd, Providence, NC, died on Sat, Aug. 3, 2019 at the Brian Center in Yanceyville, NC after being in declining health for several years.

Mr. Poteat was born in Caswell County, NC on January 28, 1919, son of the late Eddie Preston Poteat and the late Nettie Foster Poteat.
