



## Olive Levers Olenick

July 1, 1947 - September 1, 2021

Olive Eileen Levers Olenick, 74, of Sutherlin, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, September 1, 2021, after a decline in health for the last year and a half.

Mrs. Olenick was born in Washington, PA, on July 1, 1947, a daughter of the late Frank James Levers and the late Gail Estela Smith Levers. She lived most of her life in the Danville area where she worked for the former Danville Regional Medical Center as a Patient Liaison. She was a faithful member of Sandy Creek Baptist Church, where she served as church secretary, Sunday school teacher, WMU President, Youth Group Leader, and sang in the choir. 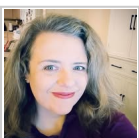
