Omega Wayne Prevette Peek, age 84, of Ringgold VA, died on Tuesday, March 25, 2025, peacefully at her daughter's home in Bailey NC. She was born on April 5, 1940 to the late Samuel Beecher Prevette and Julia Creason Prevette.

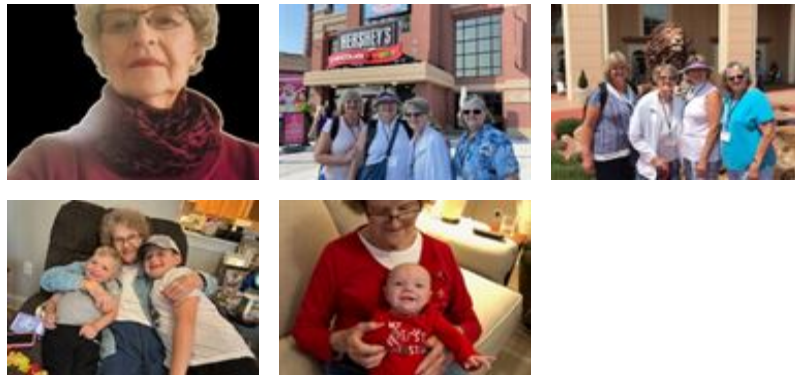
