September 16, 1929 - October 10, 2012

Paul Boykin Kuykendall, 83, of 3997 Westover Drive Danville, died Wednesday, October 10, 2012 at Danville Regional Medical Center after a decline in health for the past six months.

Born in Henderson County, NC on September 16, 1929 he was the son of the late Rufus Monroe Kuykendall and Bonnie Reese Kuykendall.

Mr. Kuykendall graduated from Western Carolina College. He was an Industrial Arts Teacher for Danville Public School where he taught at Woodrow Wilson and O.T. Bonner Schools. Later he ran K's Auto Sales on Westover Drive. He served in the U.S. Army, and was a member of Fellowship Baptist Church in Eden, NC.

On April 17, 1953 he married Pauline Stepp Kuykendall, who survives.

In addition to his wife of the residence he is survived by two daughters, Donna Davis, and husband, Jimmy, of Danville; Vicky McDuffie, and husband, Gene, of Eden, NC; a son Kent Kuykendall, and girlfriend, Rachel Taylor, of Danville; three grandchildren, Rayna Sexton (Brian), Jacob Davis (Kathy), LCPL Daniel McDuffie (Fiancé Tori); step-granddaughter, Rebekah Taylor; five great-grandchildren, Trent, Lucas, Lydia, Mia, Madelyn.

He was predeceased by four brothers, and one sister.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, October 13, 2012 at 2:00 P.M. from the Wrenn-Yeatts Westover Chapel conducted by the Rev. Gene McDuffie and the Rev. Delton Agnor. Interment will follow in Danville Memorial Gardens with Flag presentation by the U.S. Army.

The family will receive friends on Friday from 7:00-8:30 P.M. at the funeral home and at the residence at other times.
