Paul Moschler, 87 of 585 Cedar Road, Ringgold, VA passed away on Friday, December 26, 2014 at Riverside Healthcare and Rehab Center after a decline in health for the past six months. Born on March 4, 1927, he was the son of the late James Moschler and Thelma Davis Moschler Barley.

Mr. Moschler was a veteran of the US Army and worked as the supervisor in the prize room for Diamond Tobacco Company, formerly Dibrell Brothers Tobacco. He lived most of his life in the Mountain Hill Community of Pittsylvania County, VA and where he attended Glen Hill Baptist Church.

On January 14, 1950 he married Melba Poindexter Moschler who survives of the residence. In addition to his wife he is survived by three children, Laverne M. Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel is respectfully serving the Moschler family.

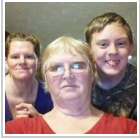
