



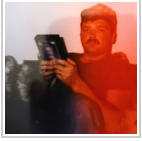
## Paul Painter

Paul Fredrick Painter, Jr. DANVILLE- Paul Fredrick Painter, Jr., 81, of 105 Lorillard Circle, died Monday, January 5, 2009 at his residence. He had been in declining health for the past five months. Mr. Painter was born in Harrisonburg, Pennsylvania on June 20, 1927, the son of the late Paul Fredrick Painter, Sr. and Thelma Good Painter. He had lived his life in Pittsylvania County and had retired from Dan River Mills, Inc. after 22 years as a supervisor.
