Paul William Saunders, 84, of 1401 Stoney Mill Rd, Danville, died Friday, January 28, 2011, at Danville Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Saunders was born on December 16, 1926, in Rockingham County, NC, the son of the late Alvis Dewey Saunders and Lola Maude Hall Saunders.

He worked for 34 years in the former Riverside Division of Dan River Inc. as a Warp Hauler, and in the Slasher Room. He served his country in the U.S. Army during WWII and Korea.

He was a faithful member of Temple Baptist Church for over 50 years where he served as an usher and taught Sunday school. He was a member of American Legion Dan River Post # 1097.

On June 10, 1952, he married Florence Powell Saunders, who died on August 21, 2010.

He is survived by two sons, Paul Jerome Saunders, and Michael Ray Saunders, both of Danville; a brother, J.D. Saunders, of Burlington, NC; and a sister, LaVonne Willis, of Ruffin, NC.

In addition to his wife, and parents he was predeceased by three brother, and three sisters.
