Margaret Wingo Pettigrew Bebeau, or "Peggy," of Danville died unexpectedly Monday, July 4, 2011 at age 73 after a brief illness. She is predeceased by her parents, Margaret Helen Wingo Pettigrew and Howell Pope "Boots" Pettigrew. Mrs. Bebeau is survived by her son, Jim Bebeau and his wife Kim, and her grandson Cooper. She is also survived by her brother-in-law Dr. Eugene Russell Bebeau, of Beaumont Texas, and her sister-in-law Mrs. Nancy Bebeau Brunschwig, and her sister-in-law's husband J.P., of Ocean Springs, Mississippi, as well as many beloved nieces and nephews across the country.
