June 23, 1932 - December 3, 2024

Peggy Sykes Gwynn, 92, of 80 Boy Scout Camp Road, Yanceyville and for most of her life a resident of Oxford, N.C., went to be with her Lord on Tuesday, December 3, 2024, dying peacefully at her home.

She had experienced declining health for quite some time. But she always had a smile and cared deeply about her close friends and family.

She was born in Caswell County on June 23, 1932, to Alfred Thomas Sykes and Lillie Jackson Sykes. Educated in Caswell County schools, she was working as a dental hygienist when she met her future husband. In Oxford, she was active in the community as a girl scout leader and in the Oxford United Methodist Church.
