Percy Lee Rowland, 97, of 1128 Pounds Road, Sutherlin, VA, died on August 29, 2024 at SOVAH in Danville, VA after a brief illness.

Lee was born in Pittsylvania County, VA on July 11, 1927, a son of the late Fitzhugh Lee Rowland and Frances Ashworth Rowland.

On April 4, 1979, he married Diane Jones Rowland, who survives of the residence.

Lee spent all of his life in Pittsylvania County and Danville area. He attended Schoolfield High School in Danville and was Captain of the baseball and football teams. He proudly served his country in the United States Navy. Lee worked in law enforcement with the City of Danville Police Department for 36 years and retired as a Lieutenant.
