



## Preston Wayne Poteat

September 28, 1946 - July 20, 2025

Preston Wayne Poteat, 78, of 5436 Walters Mill Road, Providence, NC, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, July 20, 2025 at Sovah Health in Danville, VA after two months of declining health.

Wayne was born on September 28, 1946 a son to the late Willie Preston Poteat and Hazel Page Poteat. He lived all of his life in the Providence Community of Caswell County. He graduated from the former Cobb Memorial High School and was in the last graduating class from the school in 1964. Wayne was a United States Army Veteran having served in the Vietnam War. He retired from his position as Manager of Facilities at Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company in Danville, VA, following thirty years of service. Wayne was a lifetime member of Providence Baptist Church where he had served as a deacon and a former youth leader. He formerly held the position of scout leader for Boy Scout Troop 309 in Providence.
