Rachel Neal Gosney, 93, of 3253 Ringgold Church Rd, Ringgold, VA, went home to be with her Lord on Friday, October 11, 2019 at Sovah Health after being in declining health for several months.

Ms. Gosney was born in Ringgold, VA on March 9, 1926, daughter of the late John H. Gosney and Martha Barker Gosney. She spent all of her life in the Ringgold area where she worked at Dan River Mills in the 8-A Dress as a winder operator for 44 years until her retirement in 1991.
