



## Ralph Lewis Jessen

March 3, 1938 - November 22, 2024

Ralph Lewis Jessen, 86, of Danville, VA, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, November 22, 2024, while a patient at Roman Eagle Nursing Home. He had been in declining health for the past two years.
