



## Ralph Yeaman

February 19, 1932 - June 10, 2009

Ralph Lee Yeaman, age 77, of 568 Gemstone Lane died Wednesday, June 10, 2009 at Duke University Medical Center after being in the hospital for over two months. Ralph was born on February 19, 1932 in Pittsylvania County, a son of the late Fitzhugh L. Yeaman and the late Grace McSherry Yeaman. On July 10 1952, Ralph married Barbara Thaxton Yeaman, who survives. He served his country as a member of the United States Army in the Korean War. He was also a member of the Korean Happy Warriors Association. Mr. Yeaman owned and operated his own construction company from 1957 until his retirement in 1997. Ralph was a member of Faith Memorial Baptist Church where he served on the hospitality committee and as an usher. He also served as a Boy Scout Leader for several years.
