



Randolph Traynham

December 1, 1916 - December 30, 2009

Randolph Sydnor Traynham, 93, of 2344 Riverside Drive died on Wednesday, December 30, 2009 at Riverside Health and Rehabilitation Center where he had been a residence for six years. Mr. Traynham was born on December 1, 1916 the son of the late John Edward Traynham, Sr. and the late Ella Barksdale Traynham. He lived all of his life in the Danville area where he worked for Virginia Tobacco Company as an Asst. Factory Manager for thirty years until his retirement. After his retirement he worked for Pittsylvania Hardware. He was a member of United Methodist Men's, Emanuel Bible Class, Echo's and St. Luke's United Methodist Church where he was an usher. On March 6, 1954 Mr. Traynham married Marion Shepherd Traynham who survives of Danville. He is also survived by one sister, Mildred T. Roach of Harrisonburg, VA; and one brother-in-law, James D. Carr of Danville, VA. In addition to his parents Mr. Traynham was predeceased by one sister, Ella F. Traynham; and four brothers, J.E. Traynham, Jr., W.L. Traynham, A.B. Traynham, and D.M. Traynham. Funeral services will be conducted on Monday, January 4, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. at the Wrenn-Yeatts North Main Chapel with the Reverend Linda Kusse-Wolfe officiating.
