Randy Lewis “Mouse” Raynor, 60, of 102 Springfield Road, Danville, VA, went home to be with Lord suddenly on June 22, 2019, due to his injuries received in an accident. His health had been in a decline for the past several years.

Randy was born in Danville, VA on August 26, 1958 a son of the late Lewis Preston Raynor and Shirley Dodson Raynor who survives of the residence. He had lived all of his life in Danville and Pittsylvania County where he was a graduate of Dan River High School. Randy had worked his entire life in car, truck and equipment sales. He was known as the “best car salesman in Danville” until his retirement due to health reasons. Randy had worked in the past for Woodall Chevrolet, Milam’s Truck Sales, Atkinson Truck Sales and Blackwell Dodge. Randy was a member of Mt. Tabor Baptist Church and a member of Tuscarora Country Club. He loved Winston Cup Racing, South Boston Racing, pond fishing and playing golf.

Randy is survived by one son, Carson Lewis Raynor, of Providence, NC, his mother Shirley Raynor of Danville, VA, one sister Kim R. He was predeceased by his father and one brother, Brian Keith Raynor.
